

### Requirements for Use of the NABCB Accreditation Mark

- Only clients with the NABCB mark on their certificate are entitled to use the marks illustrated below.
- A DQS India certified customer shall not use NABCB accreditation in such a manner as to bring NABCB into disrepute and shall not make any statement regarding its certification under the NABCB accreditation that NABCB may consider inaccurate, misleading, or unauthorized.
- The NABCB accreditation mark may only be used in conjunction with both the Registered Firm Mark and the DQS Mark on the customer's stationery and literature, and in its advertising subject to DQS India's conditions for use of its Mark. A customer shall place the NABCB accreditation mark next to the Registered Firm's Mark and the DQS Mark.
- The NABCB accreditation mark shall be reproduced:
  - a. Font: Arial True type (bold)  
Circle – Cyan 80% Magenta 30%; Triangle and Outline - Black 100%.  
Black & White: Circle - Black 40% and Triangle and Outline Black 100%
  - b. in a size that makes all features of the mark clearly distinguishable.
  - c. without distortion of its dimensions.
- When using the NABCB accreditation mark, its size must not exceed the size of the Registered Firm's Mark and the DQS Mark.
- NABCB accreditation mark shall not be used on a product or in such a way as to suggest that DQS and/or ANAB have certified or approved any product, process or service of a certified customer, or in any other misleading manner.

If larger boxes, etc., used for transportation includes the mark(s), a statement must be included. This could be a clear statement that "(This product) was manufactured in a plant whose quality management systems are certified as being in conformity with ISO 9001:2015, ISO 13485: 2016(specific standards)".

- Upon withdrawal of certification or NABCB accreditation from a DQS India certificate the customer shall discontinue its use of all advertising matter that contains any reference thereto including on letterhead; in any medium) and return any certification documents as required by DQS India. and /or NABCB
